PLEASE NOTE:

Due to the ongoing pandemic, we will have the following procedures in place this year to help keep our neighbors and our volunteers safe:

1. A limited number of people will be allowed in the store at a time. When you arrive, you be assigned a shopper number. You will need to wait in your car until we are ready for you to shop. We'll come get you when it is your turn.
2. Only one person will be allowed to shop per family.
3. Masks will be required at all times. We will have masks available if you need them.
4. All people entering the store will have be required to answer brief questions about any possible recent exposure to the virus and will have their temperature taken.
5. **NO CHILDREN WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE STORE.** Please do not bring children to the store or arrange for an appropriate care giver to stay with them in the car while you shop.
6. Parents shopping for multiple children will be asked to shop for one child at a time so that the presents for that child can be wrapped while you are shopping for the next child.
7. If you are finished shopping, we will ask that you wait in your car while your presents are being wrapped and we will bring them to you when they are available. If you prefer, we will provide you with wrapping paper and tape so you can wrap your presents at home.
8. Unfortunately, we will not be able to provide snacks this year. However, we will have volunteers ready to pray with you and address any needs of your family.
